Jackson Park Advisory Council December 21 2022 meeting-runoff election

Outgoing president Louise McCurry opened the meeting at c.7:20 p.m. at South Shore Cultural Center. 78 qualified or eligible members attended and voted. C. 50 others attended. Maria Stone represented the Chicago Park District and oversaw the election. McCurry welcomed all and stated that the sole purpose of the meeting per Chicago Park District was a runoff election for president between Duwain Bailey and Michael Scott following a tie vote in November. There would be no additional nominations or statements.

Parliamentarian Susan Johnson read the conditions for the election, following the Chicago Park District Guidelines, the JPAC Bylaws, and Roberts Rules of Order.

Voting was opened. Voters lined up from their rows and gave their ballot envelopes to incoming secretary Russell Pike and their ballots face down to Maria Stone, Community Affairs Manager for CPD. Maria Stone announced the voting closed and the door was closed. She led a team of incoming officers in certifying and counting the 78 valid ballots, then announced the results. Michael Scott won with 41 votes. Duwain Bailey received 37.

The meeting was announced adjourned. The new officers who assumed their positions at the end of the meeting are President- Michael Scott, Vice President Spencer Bibbs, Secretary Russell Pike, and Treasurer Eric Rogers.
