

Minutes of JPAC January 30, 2023 Monthly Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Michael Scott, President, at 6:18 p.m. A quorum of 7 voting members were present. President Scott welcomed the attendees and introduced the officers of the Jackson Park Advisory Council (JPAC) Board. He asked if everyone had read the November and December minutes. A yes response was received; hence, a motion was requested to approve the minutes. It was moved and seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Several guests from the Chicago Park District, 5th Ward Alderperson's Office, Friends of the Parks and MPAC were recognized and introduced to the members. Also, Marc Monaghan, a reporter from the Hyde Park Herald was present.

Bobbie Beckman, Jackson Park (JP) Supervisor, provided a list of activities available within Jackson Park and at the JP Field House, and the associated fees

President Scott informed the attendees that the meeting would be conducted in a workshop discussion group format. The members of each group would introduce themselves using an icebreaker statement. Then, each group would discuss what they currently liked about JPAC and Jackson Park. Secondly, they would discuss what they didn't like and what changes they would like to see.

Attendees were assigned a number from 1 to 8, then each attendee was placed in a group with the corresponding number. Eight groups were created and given the various materials to capture their comments and suggestions. The materials were collected and a summary of each group's comments and suggestions will be presented at a future meeting.

President Scott requested a motion to adjourn the meeting. It was moved and second, and unanimously approved at 7:36 p.m.

The meeting was attended by 65 individuals, which were comprised of 47 members and 18 guests. Of the 47 members in attendance 29 were currently eligible to vote; 5 became eligible to vote for the first time; and 13 were not eligible to vote.

The guests included members from the Chicago Park District; Parks Foundation; the Obama Foundation; the 5th Ward Office; MPAC; Friends Of The Park; the Hyde Park Herald; and 6 individuals who submitted applications at this meeting.
